During her tenure as president, Central Seminary has moved the campus to a new location, opened

multiple extension sites, constructed a partnership with Myanmar Institute of Theology, developed a Korean Studies program, launched a Women's Leadership Initiative, and found new ways to focus the seminary's mission in congregational health and global Christianity.

Previously, Dr. Marshall was Associate Professor of Theology at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. During part of her time at Southern, Molly was a member of Crescent Hill Baptist. Her experience in ministry is varied. She has served as youth minister, campus minister, and pastor in churches across Oklahoma, Texas, Arkansas, and Kentucky.
