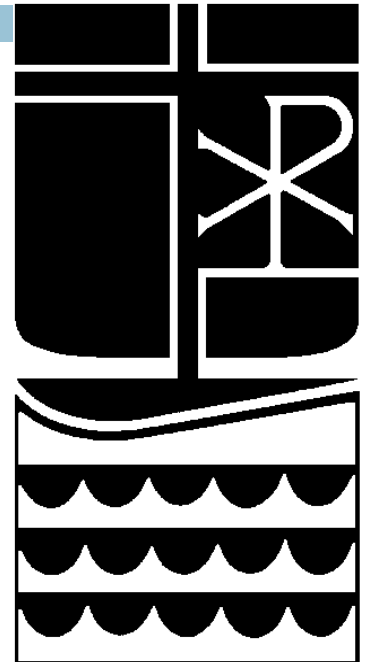


Crescent Hill Baptist Church Life Together

Outdoor Gathering, Sunday, November 1

While we still do not feel that it is wise to re-open the building for in-person worship yet, we know that it is difficult not to see each other and share fellowship. We will be offering our outdoor space for a gathering on **November 1 from 11:00 AM-12:00 noon**. Darrell Adams, Fred Bogert, and Elizabeth Weaver will be providing musical entertainment, and we will be sharing communion. (Communion elements will be available in prepackaged containers.)

We know not everyone will want to attend, and we will respect whatever decision is best for you and your family. We will offer an online service as we have been doing during the pandemic; so if you are unable to join us in person, you can still connect with us through the online service. In order to host this event safely there are several guidelines we will put in place.

1. We will have chairs set up six (6) feet apart, and some small groups of chairs to accommodate households. We ask that you stay six (6) feet apart from all other households.
2. Masks will need to be worn at all times while on church grounds by those two (2) years and over. Please bring your own mask. If you forget, we will have some you can have.
3. We need everyone to register for this event. It will be most helpful to pre-register by calling the church office by **Friday, October 30 at 4:00 PM**. Or go to the church website and register online. You can click on this link for the online form <https://form.jotform.com/202585631273152>. We are asking for everyone to register so that, in the event of someone testing positive within two weeks of the gathering, we can make sure you are contacted.
4. Please do not bring any food or drink to the gathering. Eating and drinking requires you to take off your mask, and we want you to keep your mask on at all times.
5. The building will be closed.
6. When you arrive, you can park in the courtyard parking lot, along Birchwood and Frankfort Avenues and in the library lot. There will be two check-in tables. If you have pre-registered, we will simply check you off the list and make sure you have a mask. If you haven't pre-registered, there will be a short form to fill out (name and contact information).

We look forward to seeing some of you Sunday, November 1.

A Note About Meals Offered Thanksgiving Week

It's hard to imagine that Thanksgiving is just weeks away, isn't it? Because the pandemic has placed so many restrictions on gatherings, we have decided to offer a Thanksgiving takeout meal the week of the holiday. This will be a traditional turkey dinner with all of the trimmings -including a festive dessert. We hope this might be the perfect time to plan a porch drop off for anyone you know who may be spending the holiday at home alone.

Thanksgiving meals will be offered at a slightly higher rate (\$12-\$15 range) and will be picked up on Wednesday, November 25th in lieu of our regular Tuesday pick up. (There will be NO regular "Tuesday Takeout" that week.)

Additionally, because so many people are not wanting to get out and shop in the crowded markets, we're also offering a few options for family-style side dishes. We expect to offer a selection of traditional side-dish choices such as: green beans, sweet potato casserole, sage dressing, corn pudding, garlic mashed potatoes, etc. (Final menu and prices will be available Friday, November 6) We'll have two size options available: half pans (serves 10-15 depending on serving size) and/or quarter pans (serves 4-6).

(If you are already on the "Tuesday Takeout" mailing list, you will receive the information automatically.)
