STATE ELECTIONS ON NOVEMBER 5 - BE READY!

State elections have significant influences on what does and can happen on the National level. Several main state positions are being elected: governor, attorney general, and secretary of state. Every citizen needs to vote in November. So, if you are not registered to vote, you must sign up by *October 7.* Here is who can register:

- 1. Anyone who is a US citizen over the age of 18.
- 2. If you registered once, you do not need to register again.
- 3. But, if you moved since you registered, you must turn in a change of address so you will go to the right place to vote.

We will be helping people register on Sundays. Look for the registration table! It is easy. All you need is:

- 1. Your Social Security number.
- 2. The address where you now live.
- 3. If you want to be a republican or a democrat.
