YEAR END CONTRIBUTIONS

In order to be in compliance with the Internal Revenue Service, any contributions which donors wish to be credited as a 2019 contribution for IRS purposes must be **received in the church finance office no later than noon Tuesday, December 31.** If the contribution is mailed, it must be **postmarked (not meter-dated) no later than December 31, 2019.** Contributions received after this date, regardless of the date on the check, must be reported as a 2020 contribution. Thank you for your cooperation in complying with this policy. IRS guidelines require that

members who wish to itemize contribution deductions must have a copy of the church's contribution report when filing an income tax return. Reports will be mailed in January.
